Giants Begin Six-Game Road Trip At Rancho Cucamonga Tonight... The San Jose Giants embark on a six-game road trip this evening with the first of three straight contests against the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes at The Epicenter. San Jose won two out of three games from the visiting Visalia Rawhide in their most recent series, including an 8-3 victory in the rubber match yesterday afternoon. Craig Clark won his 13th consecutive decision and league-best 14th game of the season after holding the Rawhide to three runs in eight innings. Clark struck out six and walked one as the left-hander has not suffered a defeat since May 7. Offensively, Ryan Lormand hit a three-run homer in the second inning and finished the contest with a pair of hits and four RBI's. Conor Gillaspie delivered a go-ahead two-run single in the bottom of the sixth inning as the Giants went ahead for good with four runs in the frame. San Jose finished the six-game homestand with a 4-2 record.

League-Leading Pitching Staff... The Giants enter tonight's game first in the California League with a 3.14 ERA while they've also issued the fewest walks (292) and tossed the most shutouts (10). San Jose is attempting to lead the league in pitching for the sixth consecutive season and they currently boast two out of the top four hurlers individually in ERA: Craig Clark (1st, 2.72) and Clayton Tanner (4th, 3.16). The Giants have shown improvement in their team ERA throughout each month this season (April - 3.81, May - 3.51, June - 2.83, July - 2.77, August - 2.11).

Versus The South... San Jose is 11-8 (.579) this season against teams from the South Division. The Giants have won five out of six games versus the South in the second half, including taking two of three from Rancho Cucamonga in a series at Municipal Stadium last weekend. Tonight marks San Jose's first game at a South Division opponent since April 29 at Lancaster. The Giants will play 14 out of their last 29 games against clubs from the South Division.

Minor League Leaders... Craig Clark is tied for the minor league lead with 14 wins while Roger Kieschnick is fourth in RBI's (87) and Thomas Neal is tied for fourth in doubles (36).

Runzler Promoted; Mixon And Turpen Return... Left-handed relief pitcher Dan Runzler was promoted to Double-A Connecticut yesterday. Runzler, who joined the Giants from Augusta (Low-A) on June 8, appeared in 19 games out of the San Jose bullpen and was 1-0 with 0.84 ERA and five saves. He struck out 26 and walked just four over 21 1/3 innings while holding the opposition to a .104 batting average. David Mixon (2-1, 3.40 ERA, 2 SV) and Daniel Turpen (3-1, 1.40 ERA, 5 SV) have returned to the Giants from Fresno (AAA). The duo was promoted earlier in the week and each pitched in one game for the Grizzlies.

Road Warriors... Beginning tonight, San Jose will play 19 out of their final 29 games away from Municipal Stadium. The Giants own the best road record in the California League at 30-21.

The Ford File... Center fielder Darren Ford has turned around his season batting .329 in 140 at-bats during the second half after hitting at just a .207 clip over 140 at-bats before the All-Star break. Ford began switch-hitting last off-season, but gave it up during the All-Star break and is again batting exclusively from the right side. The 23-year old hit .173 in May and .189 in June before breaking out with a .352 batting average (37-for-105) in July. Ford has also stolen eight bases in his last nine contests and has been successful in 10 out of his last 11 attempts overall.

Third-Best Record In Minor League Baseball... San Jose (72-39, .649) currently owns the third-best overall record among full-season teams in all of minor league baseball. The Giants trail only the Low-A Fort Wayne TinCaps (76-34, .691) and the Double-A Birmingham Barons (73-37, .664).

Bullpen Streaks Snapped... The Giants saw two long streaks snapped during the last homestand. Three nights ago marked the first time since June 20 (40 games) that a San Jose reliever was charged with a blown save when Ryan Shaver failed to hold a one-run lead in the seventh inning. Meanwhile in Sunday's 11-inning defeat to Rancho Cucamonga, Trey Webb was charged with the loss - the first time a member of the Giants bullpen suffered a loss since May 31 (58 games).

Today's Opponent: Rancho Cucamonga Quakes... The Rancho Cucamonga Quakes, an affiliate of the Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim, enter tonight's match-up with a 51-60 overall record and a 21-20 mark in the second half - one game behind High Desert for the top spot in the South Division. The Quakes have won their last four games while they're currently tied for seventh in the league in batting average (.264), sixth in ERA (4.48), ninth in home runs (59), second in stolen bases (124) and tied for fifth in fielding percentage (.971).
